What is The K12 Digital Inclusion Survey?

Purpose:

Effort to collect baseline data concerning the state of digital instruction in Texas to be incorporated into the forthcoming Digital Curriculum Advisory Committee (DCAC) report to the State Board of Education (SBOE).

Intended Audience:

Administrators, curriculum coordinators, general and special education teachers/support personnel, and IT personnel

What is The K12 Digital Inclusion Survey?

Estimated Completion Time:

The K12 Digital Inclusion Survey should take less than 15-minutes to complete, with a total of 22 questions covering a range of digital curriculum and accessibility topics.

The survey will be submitted confidentially with data aggregated at the district level and not at the campus level. While the survey is not mandated, it is encouraged to provide more accurate data from a diverse range of LEAs.

How are the DCAC, Report, and K2 Survey all Connected?

DCAC



In 2019, TEA established the DCAC, including a diverse group of subject matter experts spanning K-12.

DCAC Digital Curriculum Report



The DCAC report identifies challenges in digital inclusion for students with disabilities and makes recommendations to the SBOE.

K12 Digital Inclusion Survey connection

Collected survey data will be used to supplement and reinforce report recommendations.

To advise the SBOE on how to best ensure equal access to digital curriculum for students with disabilities.
