



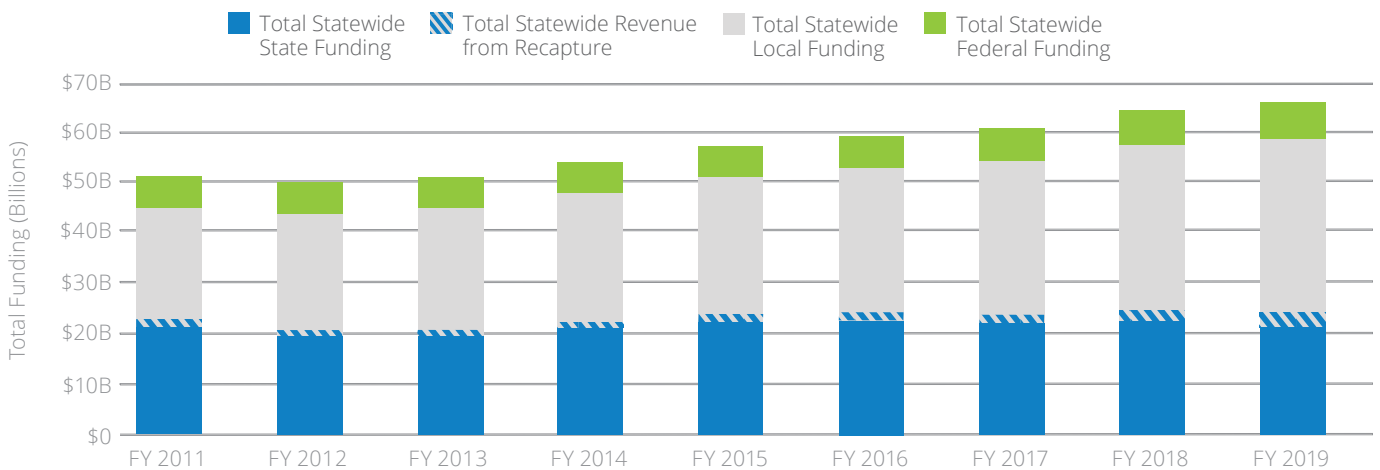
# School Finance

The Texas public education system is funded through local property tax collections, state funding and federal dollars. The Permanent School Fund – the country’s largest educational endowment – also contributes to the system each year. Most of the state and federal funding is allocated to school systems based on needs-based weighted per-pupil funding formulas.<sup>18</sup> Note: HB 3 funding increases begin with FY 2020.

## TOTAL FUNDING – 2018-19

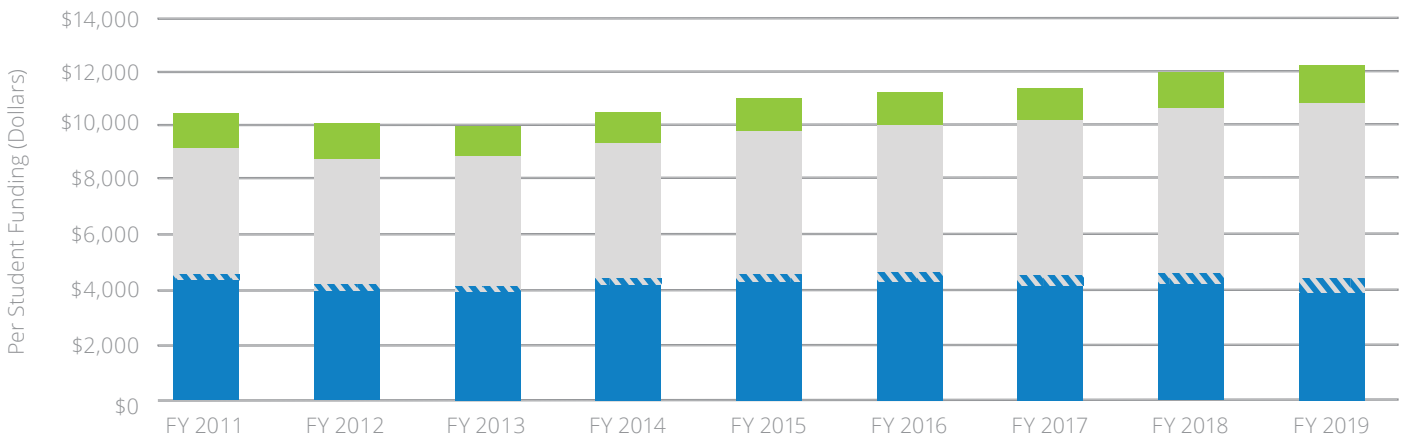

### TOTAL ANNUAL FUNDING



Total funding has increased from \$51.58B in FY 2011 to \$66.23B in FY 2019, an increase of 28%.

### PER STUDENT ANNUAL FUNDING



Total funding per student enrolled has increased from \$10,503 in FY 2011 to \$12,227 in FY 2019, an increase of 21%.
