

# CCMR Outcomes Bonus Funding Timeline Changes

May 2024 Superintendent Call

## **Context: CCMR Outcomes Bonus**

- Under House Bill 3 (HB 3), 86th Legislature, 2019, the agency awards districts CCMR Outcomes Bonus funding.
- TAA from April 11
- Funding is awarded based on the number of annual graduates who demonstrate college, career, or military readiness in excess of a threshold for three cohorts
  - annual graduates who are economically disadvantaged;
  - annual graduates who are not educationally disadvantaged; and
  - annual graduates who are enrolled in a special education program.




## College ready in CCMR OB is defined as:

- Earns an associate degree, or
- Meets Texas Success Initiative (TSI) criteria and enrolls at a postsecondary institution immediately following high school.


# Career ready in CCMR OB is defined as:

- Meets Texas Success Initiative (TSI) criteria, and
- Earns an industry-based certification (IBC) or earns a level I or level II certificate


# **<u>Current state</u>: CCMR OB funding is estimated using data from previous years and is settled up at the end of the year**



### <u>Updates for this year</u>: New Early Counts gives districts a better estimate of funding for FY2023–24



### **Future State: New Early Counts allows future payments to be based on actuals rather than estimates**



Note: DPE is provided to help districts plan, but does not change payment amount during the school year





### 2024 College, Career, and Military Readiness (CCMR)

The CCMR Tracker allows districts to identify and target resources toward high school students who have yet to demonstrate college, career, or military readiness.

Please note, the CCMR Tracker, includes CCMR outcomes reported though TSDS PEIMS, TSIA results, and OnRamps course completion through the 2022–23 school year; SAT, ACT, AP, IB and level I/II certificate results though the 2021–22 school year. 
