- ▶ To improve the educational experience for teacher candidates through EPPs.
- ▶ To improve EPPs.

- ▶ You can complete the evaluation in more than one session if needed.
- ▶ Once submitted, you will receive a CPE certificate to recognize your fulfillment of this requirement.
