#### CTE Programs of Study Updates

- o CTE Programs of Study Refresh for 24-25 Published March 21, 2024
- March 21 TAA on Programs of Study: Refreshed CTE programs of study will be implemented beginning with the 2024-2025 school year. Changes to programs of study are additive and should not negatively impact students who have already started a program of study.
- Based on recommendations from a cross-sector advisory committee, the Texas Education Agency (TEA) released a preliminary <u>2024-2025 programs of study change crosswalk</u> in October 2023. The changes are now final and are reflected in <u>updated program of study</u> framework documents.

#### Middle School Advanced Mathematics

- Middle School Advanced Mathematics Program
- Overview of Middle School Advanced Mathematics Program Requirements Published March 21, 2024
- In 2023, Senate Bill 2124 (88th Texas Legislature, Regular Session) was signed into law, establishing <u>Texas Education Code (TEC)</u>, §28.029, <u>Middle School Advanced</u>
   <u>Mathematics Program</u>. The law requires school districts and open-enrollment charter schools to develop an advanced mathematics program for middles school students that is designed to enable students to enroll in Algebra I in eighth grade.
- Tomorrow, March 28, 2024: To help support the implementation of middle school advanced mathematics programs, TEA will conduct a webinar for local education agencies (LEAs) on Thursday, March 28, 2024, at 2:00 pm (Central). Attendees must register for the webinar in advance.

- On Monday, April 8, 2024, parts of Texas in a northeasterly direction from Eagle Pass to Texarkana, will experience four and a half minutes of total darkness during the 2024 Total Solar Eclipse from approximately 1:27 PM to 1:49 PM.
- Superintendents should connect with their county Emergency Management Coordinator ahead of time to prepare for any possible issues and challenges.
