September 1, 2007	Senate Bill 1031 goes into effect
September 28, 2007	Growth pilot study design presented to the Texas Technical Advisory Committee (TTAC)
October 2007-June 2008	Growth model pilot study analyses conducted
February 15, 2008	Growth model proposals due to USDE for the 2007-2008 school year
February 18, 2008	TEA provides growth/projection model information to Select Committee on Public School Accountability
April 17, 2008	TEA shares pilot study analysis plan and schedule with the Student Assessment Advisory Committee (SAAC)
June 5, 2008	Growth pilot study presented to the District Advisory Committee
July 15, 2008	Growth pilot study preliminary results presented to the TTAC
August 11, 2008	First draft of growth pilot study report and executive summary completed
August 18, 2008	USDE notifies states that growth model proposals are due to USDE by October 15, 2008, for 2008-2009 school year
September 5, 2008	TEA convenes meeting of school district personnel to discuss growth/projection models
September 23, 2008	USDE guidance on growth proposal submissions issued
October 15, 2008	Texas submits growth proposal to meet USDE submission deadline
October 23, 2008	TEA shares summary of proposed growth model with the SAAC
November 6, 2008	TEA presents USDE proposal to the TTAC for review
November 7, 2008	Final decisions on Texas model(s) in order to meet spring 2009 assessment reporting timelines
November 12, 2008	USDE deadline for responding to clarifying questions on growth proposals submitted October 15, 2008
December 2-3, 2008	USDE convenes a group of peers to review growth proposals submitted by states
January 8, 2009	Secretary of Education announces decision to approve Texas' growth model proposal
March 5, 2009	TEA posts supporting documents for the Texas Projection Measure
April 2009	TEA posts documents describing the computation procedures for the Texas Projection Measure
Spring 2009	Student growth/projection reports provided to districts
Summer 2009	Use of growth/projection measure in federal AYP accountability and state accountability system planned
Fall 2009	Student growth/projection reports provided online to districts
