1. \_\_\_ Failure to attend required provider training.
2. \_\_\_ Failure to demonstrate financial soundness.
3.  Making a false representation or providing false information to TEA/district/parent.  
*Provider submitted false information to the district for the purposes of invoicing and payment for tutoring services not provided*
4. \_\_\_ Failure to meet civil rights laws.
5. \_\_\_ Failure to meet all applicable federal, state, and local health and safety requirements.
6.  Failure to meet state and Local Education Agency (LEA) criminal history / fingerprinting requirements.
7. \_\_\_ Failure to comply with the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) and any regulations or policies concerning the protection and use of confidential and student identifying information

Provider is immediately removed from the Texas State-approved SES provider list for the remainder of the school year. The LEA(s) responsible for students the Provider presently serves will be directed to reassign students to the next provider of choice of the students' parents.

Provider may reapply during the next application period.
