The Met Standard level cannot be obtained with less than a '2' on the written composition portion.

At the 2 SEM standard a composition score of '1' plus 25 or more multiple-choice items and short answer score points or a composition score of '0' plus 29 or more multiple-choice items and short answer score points will result in the scale score corresponding to one point below the Met Standard level.

At the 1 SEM standard a composition score of '1' plus 28 or more multiple-choice items and short answer score points or a composition score of '0' plus 32 or more multiple-choice items and short answer score points will result in the scale score corresponding to one point below the Met Standard level.

At the Panel Recommendation standard a composition score of '1' plus 32 or more multiple-choice items and short answer score points or a composition score of '0' plus 36 or more multiple-choice items and short answer score points will result in the scale score corresponding to one point below the Met Standard level.

A written composition score of '3' or higher is required to achieve the THECB Higher Education Readiness Standard level.

A written composition score of '2' or higher is required to achieve the Commended Performance level.
