Proclamation 2017 calls for materials for all courses in career and technical education and languages other than English. It also calls for materials for Special Topics in Social Studies, Algebraic Reasoning, and Statistics.

The State Board of Education (SBOE) issued *Proclamation 2017* at its April 2015 meeting and approved amendments to the proclamation at its September 2015 meeting.
