# AMENDMENT TO STANDARD CONTRACT BETWEEN TEXAS EDUCATION AGENCY AND

# EDUCATIONAL TESTING SERVICE ("ETS"),

a nonprofit, non-stock corporation organized and existing under the Education Law of the State of New York, with principal offices located at Carter and Rosedale Roads, Princeton, New Jersey, 08541.

### CONTRACTOR

It is mutually understood and agreed by and between the undersigned contracting parties of the above numbered contract to amend said Contract effective October 14, 2016 as follows:

### ARTICLE III. PURPOSE OF CONTRACT

Contractor shall continue to perform all of the functions and duties in the Contract and changes to work functions described in the Narrative by ETS, Amendment 1, dated October 14, 2016 attached herein and incorporated by reference. Contractor shall administer the STAAR® assessments from September 1, 2016 through August 31, 2019. The Contract may be extended for one (1) additional fiscal year under the same or different terms subject to appropriation of funds by the Texas Legislature for this project. The renewal period shall be from September 1, 2019 through August 3, 2020.

### ARTICLE IV. PAYMENT UNDER CONTRACT

Subject to the availability to TEA of funds for the purposes of this contract, TEA shall pay to Contractor by State of Texas warrant(s) the amount of <u>\$ 68,662,197.00</u> for the performance in fiscal year 2017, satisfactory to the TEA, of Contractor's functions and duties under this Contract. Total contract amount is estimated <u>\$278,172,848.00</u> based on the revised deliverables identified in this Amendment. The revised deliverables and associated budget labeled Exhibit 1, is attached and hereby incorporated by reference in the Amendment.

Texas Government Code §2252.901 prohibits the agency into entering into an employment contract, a professional services contract, or a consulting services contract with a former or retired TEA employee before the first anniversary of their last date of regular employment. If TEA enters into a "professional services" contract with a corporation, firm, or other business entity that employs a former or retired employee during the first year of the past employee's departure from the agency, the former or retired employee is restricted from performing services on projects that the employee worked on while employed at TEA.

Texas Government Code §572.069. CERTAIN EMPLOYMENT FOR FORMER STATE OFFICER OR EMPLOYEE RESTRICTED. A former state officer or employee of a state agency who during the period of state service or employment participated on behalf of a state agency in a procurement or contract negotiation involving a person may not accept employment from that person before the second anniversary of the date the officer's or employee's service or employment with the state agency ceased.

Receipts must be made available for programmatic or financial audit, by TEA and by others authorized by law or regulation to make such an audit, for a period of not less than seven (7) years.

It is agreed and accepted by a person authorized to bind Contractor that all Terms and Conditions of this Amendment are effective commencing on the above date.

# Exhibit 1: Narrative for ETS Contract Amendment 1: FINAL October 14, 2016:

1. Lexiles: Beginning with the spring 2016 test administration, ETS will provide Lexile scores for both English and Spanish versions of the STAAR grades 3, 4, and 5 assessments. Lexile scores will be incorporated into the Confidential Student Reports (CSRs) and the student data files. Lexile scores will be linked to the STAAR score scale by means of a stand-alone linking study. ETS will make available Lexile interpretative materials as directed by the Agency. Providing Spanish Lexile measures, which were not part of the original contract, increases the price of the ETS contract by \$531,482 over the four years of the contract.

2. Implementation of HB 743 provisions in 2016: The current contract with ETS dated August 2015 accounts for the implementation of HB 743 beginning with the spring 2017 test administration. This amendment reduces the price of the ETS contract by \$4,971,140. The reduction in price is due to eliminating the administration and scoring of one essay in both grades 4 and 7 writing in 2016, a year earlier than provided for in the original contract. In addition to the impact on grades 4 and 7 constructed response scoring, the field-test items in all other grades and content areas were removed to shorten STAAR grades 3–8 tests for spring 2016. As a result, the number of items to be developed was reduced over the first two years of the contract.

3. Implementation of HB 1164: As described in the document "Writing Pilot Proposal Final Draft" dated 6/1/2016, the pilot study will measure writing skills at grades 4 and 7 and at the high school level through the English I and English II end-of-course assessments. ETS will design a pilot study approved by TEA by November 1, 2016, and then conduct the pilot study for school years 2016–2017 and 2017–2018. By August 2018, ETS will produce a technical report on the results of this study. Implementing this pilot study increases the price of the ETS contract by \$1,568,646.

### Pilot Study Price by Contract Year

4. <u>Score report redesign</u>: ETS will redesign the Confidential Student Reports (CSRs) to be used beginning with the spring 2017 test administration. This redesign will incorporate review and recommendations from educators and parents throughout Texas. While the original proposal specified a single Austin-based focus group with additional virtual participants, at TEA's request we have changed the plan to hold focus groups in each of the 20 education service centers. The timeline for completion of focus groups and gathering suggestions from the field has extended into the second contract year. The planning and execution of this redesign including the additional focus groups will increase the price of the ETS contract by \$268,004 in year 1 of the contract.

5. <u>Deferred external meetings</u>: 8 of the 25 external item and prompt review committee meetings scheduled for summer 2016 are being deferred into 2017 at the request of TEA due to the reduction in the number of items to be developed (see #2 above). This shift results in a transfer of \$597,600 from year 1 to year 2 of the contract.

6. <u>Annual release of test forms</u>: The original contract stipulated release of test forms at the end of 2016 and then three years later (2019). Based on the Commissioner's decision, ETS will now release online test forms annually for years 1, 2, 3, and 4; and paper test forms annually for years 2, 3, and 4 of the contract as described in the document "Plan for Annual Release of Test Forms" dated 6/28/2016. In addition to the work for preparing the forms for release, additional item development for years 1, 2, 3, and 4 is included to replace the released items. The

planning and execution of the annual release of paper test forms will increase the price of the ETS contract by \$376,200 (braille form release); \$315,194 in year 2; \$322,218 in year 3; and \$314,140 in year 4 of the contract. The planning and execution of the annual release of online test forms will increase the price of the ETS contract by \$1,249,560 in year 1; \$944,256 in year 2; \$716,060 in year 3; and \$735,493 in year 4 of the contract.

7. <u>Cancellation of June grades 5 and 8 retest administration</u>: The Commissioner's decision to cancel the June 21 and June 22 retest administration for STAAR grades 5 and 8 mathematics and reading tests resulted in a savings of \$302,996 for charges in inventory control, resolutions, scanning, online testing support, scoring, psychometric and statistical analysis, and score reporting not performed.

8. <u>APIP coding for 2015 item development</u>: STAAR EOC field-test items from 2015 have not yet been APIP coded. This will be done in year 2 with associated budget being shifted into that year. For STAAR grades 3–8 items, there are 7,500 items remaining in the bank to be APIP coded. This work is underway and will extend into year 2. Associated budget will be shifted from year 1 to year 2. This activity will take into consideration the Personal Needs Preferences (PNP) specifications that are being developed in year 1.

9. <u>Stand-alone field test for writing prompts</u>: At TEA's request, ETS will move the scheduled field test of writing prompts from spring 2017 to fall 2017. The budget associated with administration and scoring of the field test will be shifted to year 3 of the contract. However, budget associated with planning, including committee meetings and materials preparation, will remain in year 2 of the contract.
