Indicator: The Performance-Based Monitoring Analysis System (PBMAS) reports performance and program effectiveness on a variety of indicators. 2010 Numerator: The number of events observed in a particular indicator (e.g. the number of students passing a TAKS subjectarea test).

2010 Denominator: This represents the total population evaluated in a particular indicator (e.g. the number of students taking the TAKS subject-area test).
