1. Call to Order

The State Board for Educator Certification convened its meeting at 9:00 a.m. on Friday, June 8, 2012 in Room 1-104 of the William B. Travis Building, 1701 N. Congress Avenue in Austin, Texas.

Dr. Cain introduced new board member, Dr. Judy Loredo, representative for the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board.

2. Recognition

Dr. Cain recognized Sandra Gray and Amy Trietsch, two 2012 national scholarship winners presented by the National Association for Alternative Certification. Dr. Cain also recognized Dr. Peggy Malone, of Region 11 Education Service Center and Dr. Andrae Rhyne and Ms. Valinda Samples of the Dallas ISD Alternative Certification Program.

3. Associate Commissioner's Comments Regarding the SBEC Agenda

Dr. Smisko reviewed the agenda.

5. Approval of February 3, 2012 Board Meeting Minutes

Motion and Vote:

Motion was made by Ms. Bricker to approve the February 3, 2012 board meeting minutes. Second was made by Ms. Bridges and the Board voted unanimously in favor of the motion.

DISCUSSION AND ACTION

6. Adoption of Review of 19 TAC Chapter 227, <u>Provisions for Educator Preparation</u> <u>Candidates</u>

Dr. Smisko informed the Board that this item is presented for the purpose of concluding the review of 19 TAC Chapter 227, Provisions for Educator Preparation Candidates.

Ms. Bricker suggested that 19 TAC §227.1(b), <u>General Provisions</u>, should read "Educator preparation programs **must** collaborate with local school districts..." instead of "**should** collaborate." Ms. Bricker also suggested that because Subchapter B, <u>Preliminary Evaluation of Certification Eligibility</u>, addresses the implementation of a preliminary criminal history evaluation, educator preparation programs should have a method in place to inform prospective candidates that they may request a preliminary criminal history evaluation letter before entering the program.

Motion and Vote:

Motion was made by Dr. Culwell to adopt the review of 19 TAC Chapter 227, <u>Provisions for Educator Preparation Candidates</u>. Second was made by Ms. Bricker and the Board voted unanimously in favor of the motion.

7. Adoption of Review of 19 TAC Chapter 228, Requirements for Educator Preparation Programs

Dr. Smisko informed the Board that this item is presented for the purpose of concluding the review of 19 TAC Chapter 228, <u>Requirements for Educator Preparation Programs</u>.

Motion and Vote:

Motion was made by Ms. Everest to adopt the review of 19 TAC Chapter 228, Requirements for Educator Preparation Programs. Second was made by Mr. Allard and the Board voted unanimously in favor of the motion.

8. Adoption of Proposed Amendments to 19 TAC Chapter 228, Requirements for Educator Preparation Programs, §228.2, Definitions, and §228.35, Preparation Program Coursework and/or Training

Mr. Allen informed the Board that the proposed amendments would be necessary as a result of Senate Bill (SB) 8, 82ndTexas Legislature, First Called Session, 2011, which requires flexible options for any field-based experience required for certification, and SB 866, 82ndTexas Legislature, 2011, which requires dyslexia training in undergraduate university programs.

Mr. Allen also informed the Board that staff is in the process of reviewing 19 TAC Chapters 227, 228, and 229 and that comprehensive changes to these chapters would be presented at a future meeting.

Motion was made by Ms. Bricker to approve for adoption, subject to State Board of Education review, the proposed amendments to 19 TAC Chapter 228, Requirements for Educator Preparation Programs, §228.2, Definitions, and §228.35, Preparation Program Coursework and/or Training, with an effective date of 20 days after filing as adopted with the Texas Register. Second was made by Mr. Allard and the Board voted unanimously in favor of the motion.

9. Adoption of Proposed Repeal of and New 19 TAC Chapter 230, <u>Professional</u> Educator Preparation and Certification

Dr. Lopez notified the Board that staff is recommending a change to add a definition for "appropriate," which clarifies the appropriate placement of a candidate as related to the certification, assignment, and examination. Dr. Lopez also informed the Board that staff has addressed all public comments received.

Motion was made by Mr. Allard to approve for adoption, subject to State Board of Education Review, the proposed repeal of 19 TAC Chapter 230, Professional Educator Preparation and Certification, Subchapter A, Definitions; Subchapter B, Assessment of Educators; Subchapter M, Certification of Educators in General; Subchapter N, Certificate Issuance Procedures; Subchapter O, Texas Educator Certificates Based on Certification and College Credentials from Other States or Territories of the United States; Subchapter P, Requirements for Standard Certificates and Specialized Assignments or Programs; Subchapter Q, Permits; Subchapter S, Educational Aide Certificate; and Subchapter V, Induction Training for Beginning Teachers, and proposed new 19 TAC Chapter 230, Professional Educator Preparation and Certification, Subchapter A, General Provisions; Subchapter B, General Certification Requirements; Subchapter C, Assessment of Educators; Subchapter D, Types and Classes of Certificates Issued; Subchapter E, Educational Aide Certificate; Subchapter F, Permits; Subchapter G, Certificate Issuance Procedures: and Subchapter H, Texas Educator Certificates Based on Certification and College Credentials from Other States or Territories of the United States, with an effective date of 20 days after filing as adopted with the Texas Register. Second was made by Ms. Druesedow and the Board voted unanimously in favor of the motion.

10. Adoption of Proposed Repeal of and New 19 TAC Chapter 232, <u>General Certification Provisions</u>

Dr. Lopez notified the Board that staff is not recommending any additional changes since published as proposed.

Second was made by Dr. Culwell and the Board voted unanimously in favor of the motion.

11. Adoption of Proposed Revisions to 19 TAC Chapter 233, <u>Categories of Classroom</u> Teaching Certificates

Dr. Lopez notified the Board that staff is recommending two minor changes: 1) specify the expiration date for the Technology Applications: Grades 8-12 certificate and the issuance date for the Technology Applications: Grades 7-12 certificate in order to allow more time to develop the new certification examination and 2) change the name of the Business Management and Administration: Grades 6-12 certificate to Business and Finance: Grades 6-12 as a result of staff completing a crosswalk for the proposed new certificate, which combines two different areas for career and technical education (CTE).

12. Consideration of and Opportunity to Approve A Panel of Experts for Dyslexia Educator Preparation Required in Texas Education Code §21.044(b) and (c)(1) and (2)

Dr. Lopez informed the Board the proposed panel would be necessary as a result of Senate Bill (SB) 866, 82nd Texas Legislature, 2011, which requires a panel of experts from institutions of higher education to create modules addressing characteristics of dyslexia, the identification of dyslexia and the strategies for teaching students indentified with dyslexia.

Motion was made by Mr. Allard to approve the panel of experts for dyslexia educator preparation required in Texas Education Code §21.044(b) and (c)(1) and (2). Second was made by Ms. Everest and the Board voted unanimously in favor of the motion.
