

Explanation of the 2013 PBMAS State Longitudinal Report

Indicator: The Performance-Based Monitoring Analysis System (PBMA) reports performance and program effectiveness on a variety of indicators. Detailed information on the indicators can be found in each year's PBMA Manual, available at <http://www.tea.state.tx.us/pbm/PBMAManuals.aspx>.

2013 Standard: This is the established level of performance used to evaluate performance and program effectiveness.

2013 State Rate: This represents the performance of the state as a whole on a particular indicator (c/d=b).

2013 Numerator: The number of events observed in a particular indicator (e.g. the number of students scoring at the beginning proficiency level).

2013 Denominator: This represents the total population evaluated in a particular indicator (e.g. the number of students tested on the TELPAS reading test).
