Request a New TEASE Account and Access to a Specific Application

Many TEA web applications, such as Accountability, eGrants, and PEIMS Edit+ are protected by the Texas Education Agency Security Environment (TEASE) security gateway. If your job requires you to use a secure TEA web application protected by the Texas Education Agency Security Environment (TEASE), follow the instructions below to request access. Your request is routed to your organization head (superintendent, director) and then to TEA for approval. If access is approved, you will receive a TEASE user name and password that can be used to log on to any TEASE web application.

Locate the Request Form Online

1. On the TEA website main page, <u>www.tea.texas.gov</u>, click **TEA Secure Applications Information** at the top of the page.




2. In the list of applications, find the web application you need access to and click **Request Access**Online or, if the application requires a paper form, click the link to open the request form.

(Most applications can be requested online. For the few that cannot be accommodated by the online approval process, access is requested via a paper or PDF form that is signed, scanned, and sent to TEA for processing.)

If a PDF or Paper Request Form is Required

If the application you need access to requires a PDF/paper form (for example, Accountability), a link to the form is displayed in the Request Access column.



- 1. Click the link to open the form.
- 2. Complete the form, print and sign it, obtain other required signatures.
- 3. Submit it to the appropriate TEA contact as indicated on the form.


If your access is approved, you will receive two system generated email notifications when your account is set up in the system. One notification contains your new TEASE account user ID and one contains a temporary password.

If You Can Request Access Online


If you see a link to request access online, follow the steps below to set up a TEASE account and request access to the web application at the same time.


- 1. In the same row as the application name, click **Request Access Online.**
- 2. Select Request New Account in the first paragraph.



3. Select the application you need access to from the drop down list.



4. Enter the user information required, including first and last name, organization number (usually the district / charter school / ESC six-digit county district number), and birth month and day.



- 5. Follow prompts on the screen to enter additional information required, including the role appropriate for the type of work you will perform. (If you have questions about which role is appropriate, contact the TEA program area specified on the TEA Secure Applications page.)
- 6. Click Send Request.

Review and Approval

Your completed request is generally routed to two separate people for approval:

- 1. First, the system routes it to your superintendent, director, or the person in your organization responsible for reviewing and submitting application requests. This person may submit your request as is to TEA, modify it, or deny the request.
- 2. Second, if your request is submitted by your organization head to TEA, staff in the appropriate program area at TEA review it and either approve or deny the request.

If your request is approved, you will receive email confirming that your account has been activated as well as two separate email notifications with your User ID and temporary password.

First Time Login

After you receive the two notifications with your user ID and temporary password, log in to your new TEASE account at https://seguin.tea.state.tx.us/apps/logon.asp).



When you log on for the first time, the system prompts you to choose and confirm a new password and to enter a question and answer known only to you - to be used if you forget your password. Be sure to use a question that you would always answer the same way.

Once you have logged in successfully, applications to which you have access are displayed.
