- If a student responds correctly to the first presentation of an item, the test administrator marks "A" on the scoring document, and the student receives a score point of 2.

If the student does not respond or responds incorrectly, the item is presented again with allowable teacher assists.

- If the student responds correctly to the second presentation of the item, the test administrator marks "B" on the scoring document, and the student receives a score point of 1.

- If the student does not respond or responds incorrectly to the second presentation, the test administrator marks "C" on the scoring document, and the student receives a score of point 0
