## Overview

3. WORD-PREDICTION - New accommodation applicable to Reading Language Arts, Social Studies, and Science (Positions 257, 317, 338).
4. SPELL CHECK - Accommodation name has been changed from 'Spelling Assistance' (Positions 261, 321, 341).
5. SCORE CODE DEFAULT - These fields have been replaced with blanks (Positions 356-360).
6. STAAR PROGRESS MEASURE - READING LANGUAGE ARTS (AND RELATED FIELDS) - STAAR Progress Measure will be reported (Positions 426-444).
7. EL PERFORMANCE MEASURE - New value of 4 added (Positions 445, 798, 1528, 1928).
