

Reporting Student Data File Format

Overview

Following is a list of the most significant changes being implemented in the 2024 STAAR Alternate 2 3-8 Student Data File Format.

- 1. **PEIMS ID** Field name changed from 'Student ID'. First 5 numerals will be masked with an asterisk (Position 74).
- 2. TSDS ID Field name changed from 'TX Unique Student ID' (Position 191).
- 3. **ITEM REPORTING CATEGORY NUMBERS** STAAR Alternate 2 is not released in 2024 so these fields have been replaced with blanks for each subject (Positions 445, 798, 1528, 1928).
- 4. **ITEM STUDENT RESPONSES** STAAR Alternate 2 is not released in 2024 so these fields have been replaced with blanks for each subject (Positions 503, 857, 1653, 2055).
- 5. **STAAR ALTERNATE 2 PROGRESS MEASURE READING LANGUAGE ARTS (AND RELATED FIELDS)** STAAR Progress Measure will be reported (Positions 426 444).
- 6. **STAAR ALTERNATE 2 PROGRESS MEASURE MATHEMATICS (AND RELATED FIELDS) –** STAAR Progress Measure will be reported (Positions 780 797).
- 7. FALL 2023 TSDS PEIMS CRISIS CODE 2 This field has been changed to a blank (Positions 3139-3141).
- 8. FALL 2023 TSDS PEIMS CRISIS CODE 3 This field has been changed to a blank (Positions 3142-3144).
