

Overview

The Consolidated Accountability File (CAF) combines all STAAR, STAAR Spanish, STAAR Alternate 2, TELPAS and TELPAS Alternate data within the current accountability year into one record for a student. The record also includes data for the student for any assessments within the previous accountability year. Records for which a student cannot be assigned a Texas Unique ID are not combined with data from another reporting administration, and conflicting data for a grade 3–8 subject, End of Course (EOC) or TELPAS/TELPAS ALT within a reporting administration are not combined with other testing data for a student.

For significant changes implemented in TELPAS, STAAR grades 3–8, EOC reporting, as well as TELPAS Alternate or STAAR Alternate 2, refer to individual data file formats for those assessments. The CAF data file has been condensed and field positions have been updated throughout the layout.

Following is a summary list of new and removed fields and other changes.

New and Removed Fields:

- The TEXAS UNIQUE ID (TSDS) from the individual assessment data files is used as the primary ID in the CAF.
- PERFORMANCE LEVEL INDICATOR field has been added for EOC administration for Algebra 1, English I and English II and for STAAR 3-8 administrations for Reading and Math.
- ALTERNATIVE LANGUAGE PROGRAMS field has been added.
- The following STAAR 3-8 Accountability Information has been removed
 - GRADES 5 AND 8 (PRIMARY ADMINISTRATION) (CURRENT ACCOUNTABILITY YEAR),

- STAAR 3-8 WRITING information has been removed.

New Values:

- EMERGENT BILINGUAL INDICATOR CODE replaces LEP indicator as field name
 - a. The descriptions for the Emergent Bilingual Indicator code values have been updated.
- RECORD UPDATE INDICATOR definitions have been updated.
