Our philosophy and approach to learning is to use a student-centric tailored solutions. Where necessary, we are able to use our own diagnostic tests to determine a student's academic plan. Our Education Consultants (ECs) work with the family directly and review the diagnostic results, determine the specific need of that student, create goals for tutoring and a plan of action. After the plan is created, our ECs work with our Tutor Coordinator (TC) to match the student to the appropriate tutor. We consider grade level, subject, disabilities, location, personality, and personal preferences of the family. We match the student to the tutor and provide all details of the plan to the tutor. Families have the choice to request a new tutor assignment and/or to request additional subjects and grade levels.

Following our student-centric approach to education, we use the local school's curriculum. Our tutors work closely with the teachers to get a weekly syllabus of upcoming concepts. We compare the syllabus to the diagnostic results. If there are gaps in their educational foundation, our tutoring will fill in to build those fundamental building blocks - helping them conceptually understand the topic.
