

Annual Performance Report AY 2015-16

This table shows the number of applicants to each educator preparation program; the number admitted, the number retained, and the number of completers; and finally, employment and retention statistics. The number retained and the number of completers include only teacher candidates. Similarly, the employment section includes only teacher candidates who completed during the academic year shown. Only those who were employed as teachers for the first or second academic year after completion are counted as employed. The retention section includes only candidates who obtained an initial teaching certificate during the academic year shown and were employed as teachers for the following academic year. Only those who were still employed as teachers for the fifth academic year after certification are counted as retained. Permanently employed substitute teachers are not counted as employed or as retained.

Column explanations. Comp. 13-14: Employment results are based on the number of teacher completers for academic year 2013-14 and respond to TEC §§21.045(b)(3)(E) and 21.0452(b)(7). Cert. 10-11: Five-year retention results are based on the number of initially certified completers for academic year 2010-11 who were employed as teachers for academic year 2011-12; these results respond to TEC §§21.045(b)(3)(G) and 21.0452(b)(8).
