



2020-21 Waiver for Out-of-District Transportation Interlocal Agreement Requirement of TEC §34.007(a) Attestation

SECTION I: Requirements

Districts that apply for the 2020-21 Waiver for Out-of-District Transportation Interlocal Agreement Requirement of TEC §34.007(a) must complete this form and include it as an attachment to the waiver request for the application to be considered. Any supporting documentation should be maintained locally.

The district:

- Has made a good faith effort to enter into an interlocal agreement with an outside district to provide for transporting of transfer students;
 - Documentary evidence of efforts made to enter into an interlocal agreement must be retained by the district and must have occurred within the six months immediately prior to applying for the waiver.
- Has a current, board adopted local policy that does not screen the approval of transfer enrollees on the basis of academics, discipline, or attendance, regardless of any related exemption under a local District of Innovation plan;
- Certifies that it has a 2019 academic accountability rating of A, B, or C, along with an overall score of 70 or higher; and
- Certifies that it received a 2019 district overall rating that is equal to or higher than the district from which it would be transporting students.

Failure to comply with the requirements of the waiver may result in termination of the waiver and/or denial of subsequent transportation waivers.
