

Certified Superintendent Demographics by Preparation Route 2006-2010

This table shows numbers and percentages of candidates who received their first standard Superintendent certificate through each preparation route, broken down by gender and by race or ethnicity.

Results

- Superintendents were approximately equally divided by gender; in fiscal year 2010, men were a majority.
- Superintendents were largely white, with Hispanics/Latinos making up the second largest group.
- Few Superintendents were Asian, American Indian/Alaska Native, or identified as Other.
- For most fiscal years, the university post-baccalaureate route produced more black/African American and many more Hispanic/Latino Superintendents than the remaining routes.
- The number of certified Superintendents declined over the fiscal years examined.

* Results for individual routes may not sum to the total for All Routes, because the total is a count rather than a sum. A sum of routes may contain duplication as educators can be prepared through more than one route.

Note. In 2010, 1 (0.9%) Superintendent certified through the university post-baccalaureate route reported Two or More Ethnicities (0.6% of All Routes combined).

Summary of methodology. Five tables were extracted containing identification numbers, preparation route codes, genders, and races or ethnicities of individuals obtaining their first standard Superintendent certificate for fiscal years 2005 through 2009. For each year and preparation route, a total of all Superintendents was obtained, together with counts by gender and race or ethnicity. Each count was then taken as a percentage of the corresponding total. The process was repeated to obtain overall results for all routes. Finally, the two sets of results were combined into one table.
