AMENDMENT TO INTERLOCAL COOPERATION CONTRACT BETWEEN TEXAS EDUCATION AGENCY (Receiving Party) AND

It is mutually understood and agreed by and between the undersigned contracting parties of the above referenced contract to amend said contract effective August 1, 2016 as follows:

The increase of funds is due to the increased demand for teacher and principal appraiser training prior to the roll out of the new state appraisal systems. The ESC Region 6 will be responsible for providing additional trainings than initially anticipated. Amount increased by, Task 1, \$17,500.00 and Task 2, \$17,500.00 = \$35,000.00 + \$95,000.00 original total amount = \$130,000.00, new contract amount.
