LAS Pilot Selection Process

2

- Fifty districts submitted a Notification of Interest for participation in the local accountability system pilot.
- Performance Reporting recommended 20 districts; commissioner approval is pending.
- The primary factors considered in choosing pilot districts were
 - representation of the diversity of educational settings across the state,
 - the level of local accountability work already completed,
 - and balanced regional representation.

Next Steps

3

- TEA will contact the superintendent of each district selected to explain the expectations and required commitment.
- Superintendents will have 48 hours to commit to participate in the pilot.
- A final list of participants will be announced on December 15, 2017.
- The first pilot panel meeting will be held in Austin on January 10, 2018.
- Educators not participating in the pilot can provide input through the local accountability system (LAS) website.
