# Chapter 118. Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills for Economics with Emphasis on the Free Enterprise System and Its Benefits

## Subchapter B. Other Economics Courses

#### §118.15. International Baccalaureate (IB) Economics Standard Level (SL) ( <u>Two Credits</u> [<u>One Credit</u>] ).

- (a) General requirements. One-half credit may be used to meet the course requirement in Economics for state graduation and <u>one and</u> one-half <u>credits</u> [<u>credit</u>] may be used to meet only elective course requirements for state graduation.
- (b) Content requirements. Content requirements for <u>IB</u> [<u>International Baccalaureate (IB)</u>] Economics SL are prescribed <u>by the International Baccalaureate Organization</u>. Subject guides may be obtained from <u>International Baccalaureate of North America</u> [<u>in the International Baccalaureate publication *Economics*].</u>

### §118.16. International Baccalaureate (IB) Economics Higher Level (HL) (Two Credits).

- (a) General requirements. One-half credit may be used to meet the course requirement in Economics for state graduation and one and one-half credits may be used to meet only elective course requirements for state graduation.
- (b) Content requirements. Content requirements for <u>IB</u> [<u>International Baccalaureate (IB)</u>] Economics HL are prescribed <u>by the International Baccalaureate Organization</u>. Subject guides may be obtained from <u>International Baccalaureate of North America</u> [<u>in the International Baccalaureate publication *Economics*].</u>
