"Getting Started" contains a good user guide.




When you receive an email from TEA that has been marked "Confidential" because of its information, it <u>might</u> look like this:



It's not spam.



You'll be asked to set up a password, etc – this account stays open for only 30 days.







You'll get to a secure inbox where you can read the email and reply securely.



When you receive an email WITH AN ATTACHMENT that has been identified as confidential information, it *might* look like this:








Note the subject is blank, the download is at the bottom, and it's only available for 30 days. It's not spam.

You'll be asked to verify the email and set up a passphrase before you can read and download the file.
