Student GroupsAll StudentsAfrican American	The Commended Performance indicator evaluates only two student groups: All Students and Economically Disadvantaged.
HispanicWhiteEconomically Disadvantaged	The ELL Progress Indicator and Commended Performance indicator are used to assign only <i>Recognized</i> and <i>Exemplary</i> ratings.

A district cannot be rated *Exemplary* or *Recognized* if one of its campuses is rated *Academically Unacceptable*, if it underreports 150 or more students, or if it underreports 3 percent or more of its student population.
