Explanation of the 2011 PBMAS State Longitudinal Report

Indicator: The Performance-Based Monitoring Analysis System (PBMAS) reports performance and program effectiveness on a variety of indicators. Detailed information on the indicators can be found in each year's PBMAS Manual, available at http://www.tea.state.tx.us/pbm/PBMASManuals.aspx.

2011 Standard: This is the established level of performance used to evaluate performance and program effectiveness.

2011 State Rate: This represents the performance of the state as a whole on a particular indicator (c/d=b).

2011 Numerator: The number of events observed in a particular indicator (e.g. the number of students passing a TAKS subjectarea test).

2011 Denominator: This represents the total population evaluated in a particular indicator (e.g. the number of students taking the TAKS subject-area test).
