

State PSP Requirements Matrix Guidance

The [PSP Requirements Matrix](#) document provides Districts, Schools, PSPs and ESCs with PSP requirements for schools identified in the State and/or Federal accountability system. It details the type of campus accountability rating, PSP requirement and hours, PSP contract responsibility, IR, FIR, Priority & Focus campus hours, and additional PSP contract hours for TTIPS grantees.

Note:

- PSP hourly rates for State accountability is \$85/hr (suggested).
- PSP hourly rates for Federal accountability/TTIPS grantees is \$85/hr.

<p>1st year IR only</p> <p>A PSP is required via local contract for a minimum of 50 hours (additional hours of PSP support is determined at the local level).</p> <p>TTIPS grantees will add an additional 72 hours of paid arranged services contracted through the PSP Network.</p>
<p>1st year IR & Focus</p> <p>A PSP is required via local contract for a minimum of 50 hours (additional hours of PSP support is determined at the local level).</p> <p>TTIPS grantees will add an additional 72 hours of paid arranged services contracted through the PSP Network.</p>
<p>1st year IR & Priority</p> <p>A PSP is required via local contract for a minimum of 30 IR hours (additional hours of PSP support is determined at the local level).</p> <p>1st year IR campuses also identified as Priority are allotted 110 hours of paid arranged services contracted through the PSP Network or ESC pilot.¹</p> <p>TTIPS grantees will add an additional 72 hours of paid arranged services contracted through the PSP Network.</p>
<p>2nd year IR & Priority</p> <p>A PSP is required via local contract for a minimum of 30 IR hours (additional PSP support is determined at the local level).</p> <p>2nd year IR campuses also identified as Priority are allotted 130 Priority hours of paid arranged services contracted through the PSP Network or ESC pilot.¹</p> <p>TTIPS grantees will add an additional 72 hours of paid arranged services with the PSP Network.</p>
<p>3rd year IR & Priority</p> <p>A PSP is required via local contract for a minimum of 30 IR hours (additional PSP support is determined at the local level).</p> <p>3rd year IR campuses also identified as Priority are allotted 130 Priority hours of paid arranged services contracted through the PSP Network or ESC pilot.¹</p> <p>TTIPS grantees will add an additional 72 hrs of paid arranged services with the PSP Network.</p>

4th year IR & Priority

A PSP is required via local contract for a minimum of 30 (IR) hrs (additional PSP support is determined at the local level).

4th year IR campuses also identified as Priority are allotted 110 (priority) hrs of paid arranged services contracted through the PSP Network or ESC pilot.¹

TTIPS grantees will add an additional 72 hrs of paid arranged services with the PSP Network.

5th year IR & Priority

A PSP is required via local contract for a minimum of 30 (IR) hrs (additional PSP support is determined at the local level).

5th year IR campuses also identified as Priority are allotted 110 (priority) hrs of paid arranged services contracted through the PSP Network or ESC pilot.¹

TTIPS grantees will add an additional 72 hrs of paid arranged services with the PSP Network.

Priority only (includes FIR)

Priority campuses are allotted a maximum of 20 (priority) hrs of paid arranged services contracted through the PSP Network or ESC pilot.¹ TTIPS grantees will add an additional 72 hrs of paid arranged services with the PSP Network.

NOTE:

Priority schools identified in August 2017 and served through an approved ESC pilot may have additional priority hours.

Focus only (includes FIR)

Focus campuses are not required to contract with a PSP. Utilizing support from a PSP is determined at the local level. Contact your local ESC for PSP network recommendations.

NOTE:

Focus campuses who are also TTIPS grantees are allotted 72 hrs of paid arranged services with the PSP Network.

FIR only

FIR only campuses are not required to contract with a PSP. Utilizing support from a PSP is determined at the local level. Contact your local ESC for PSP network recommendations.

NOTE:

FIR campuses who are also TTIPS grantees are allotted 72 hrs of paid arranged services with the PSP Network.

¹ PSPs can be selected through the PSP network and participating ESCs can serve in the PSP role. ESCs seeking approval to serve in PSP role, outside of the approved pilot regions (ESCs 6, 13, 18), must notify the Division of School Improvement. If participating in an external TEA planned partnership through the Instructional Leadership Initiative with Relay, Teaching Trust, New Leaders, or served through an approved ESC pilot region **please await further TEA correspondence.**
