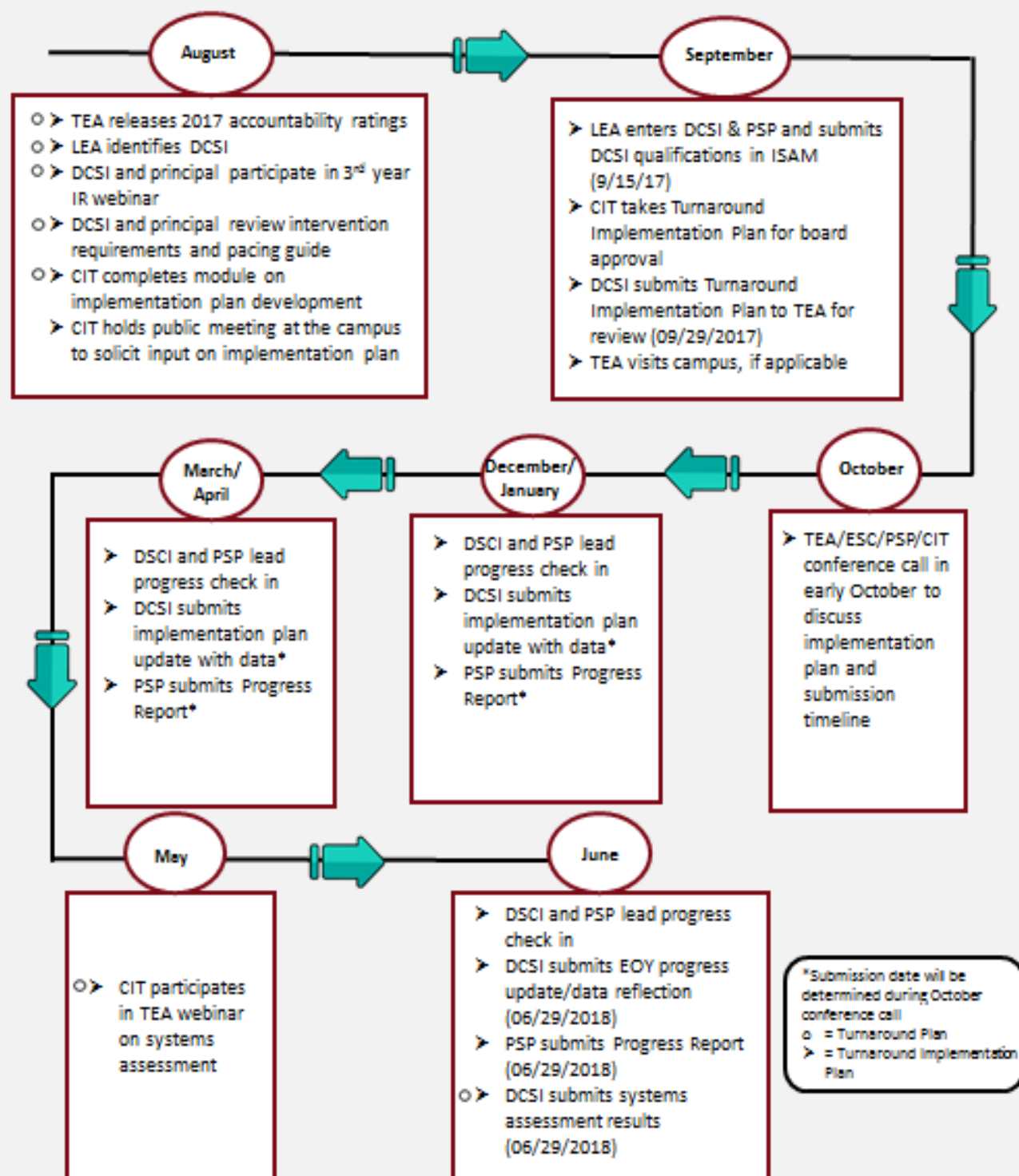

# 2017-2018 3rd Year IR Intervention Calendar

**Purpose:** Develop a targeted implementation plan using the commissioner-approved turnaround plan and monitor the student outcomes.



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## **ABOUT THE PACING GUIDE**

The purpose of the pacing guide is to provide step-by-step guidance for Campus Intervention Teams (CITs) as they navigate the school improvement process throughout the school year. This is not intended as a compliance document, and it will not be submitted to TEA.

The pacing guide is structured in a chronological manner. Following the overall 2017-2018 intervention calendar, each page is dedicated to one month with a list of all corresponding interventions and submissions as well as suggested actions to keep the CIT on track to meet all requirements.
