What's New in Performance Reporting

2019 Accountability Development

Accountability advisory groups met this week to develop recommendations for the 2019 accountability system. The Accountability Technical Advisory Committee (ATAC) includes representatives from school districts and regional education service centers (ESCs). Members make recommendations to address technical issues for 2019 accountability and beyond.

The Accountability Policy Advisory Committee (APAC) includes representatives from legislative offices, school districts, and the business community. Members identify issues critical to the accountability system and review the ATAC recommendations. The APAC either endorses the ATAC's recommendations or develops its own.

The commissioner will consider all proposals, and updates to the accountability system for 2019 will be announced later this spring.

Assessment Scoring and Reporting

The 2019 STAAR Grades 3-8 Reporting Student Data File Format and 2019 STAAR End-of-Course Reporting Student Data File Format have been posted here.

Local Accountability Systems

Three meetings were held in January to provide training and gather input on the LAS process from current and prospective LAS districts and ESC staff. Feedback from the meetings is combined with lessons learned from the LAS pilot to refine the process.

In preparation for statewide implementation of the LAS process, the TEA LAS team will be presenting at ESCs across the state and finalizing the LAS manual this spring.

This Week's FAQ

Why is the CTE Coherent Sequence Coursework Aligned with Industry-Based Certifications data in the TAPR report different than what is shown in the 2018 accountability Student Achievement: College, Career, and Military Readiness (CCMR) data tables?

The accountability CCMR data tables reports annual graduates who only met the CTE indicator and did not meet any other CCMR indicator, which subsequently earned 0.5 points for CCMR.

The TAPR reports <u>all</u> annual graduates who met the CTE indicator. This data includes graduates who earned the one point from another CCMR indicator along with those who only met CTE and earned 0.5 points. The TAPR data should be greater than or equal to what is shown on the accountability reports.
