

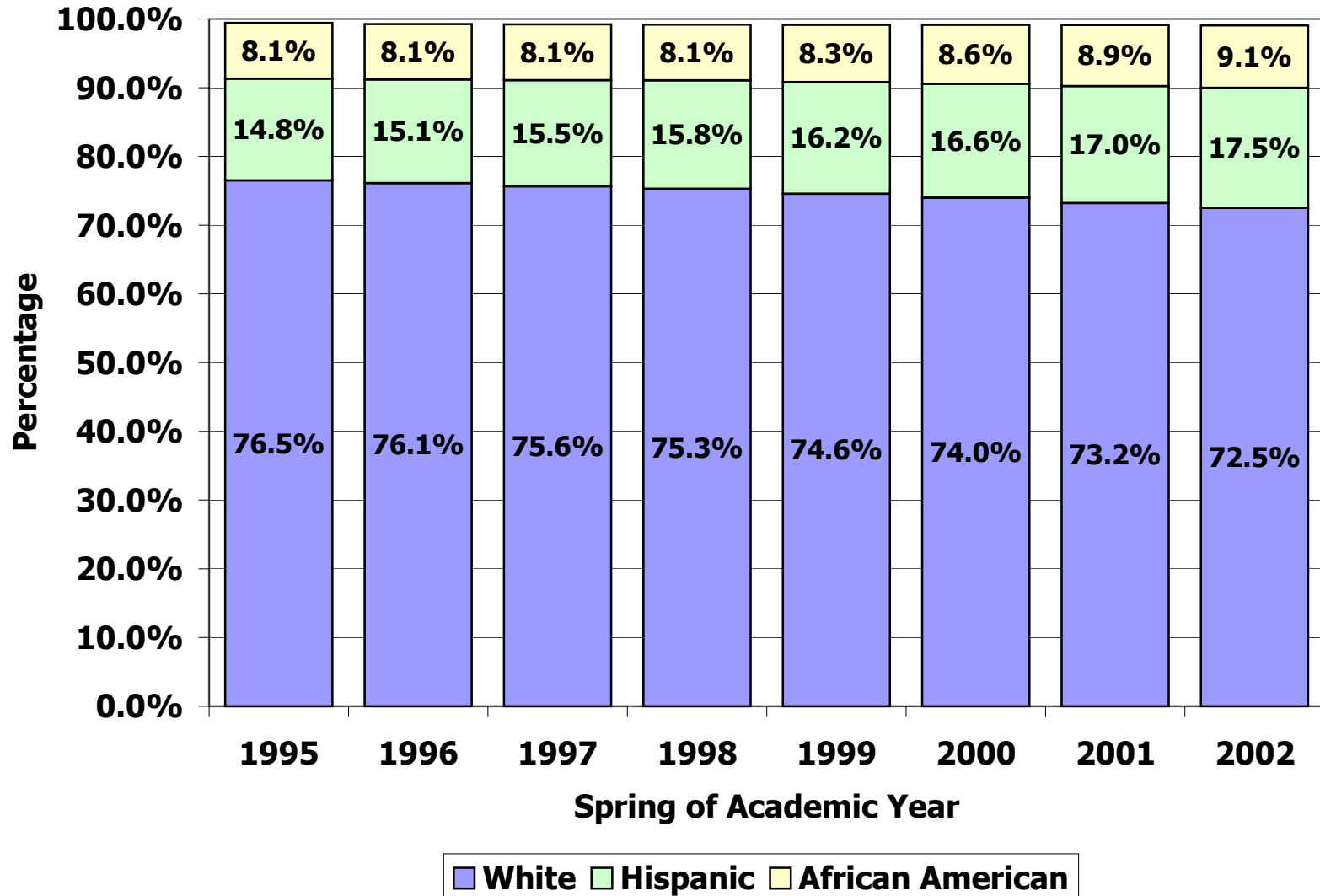

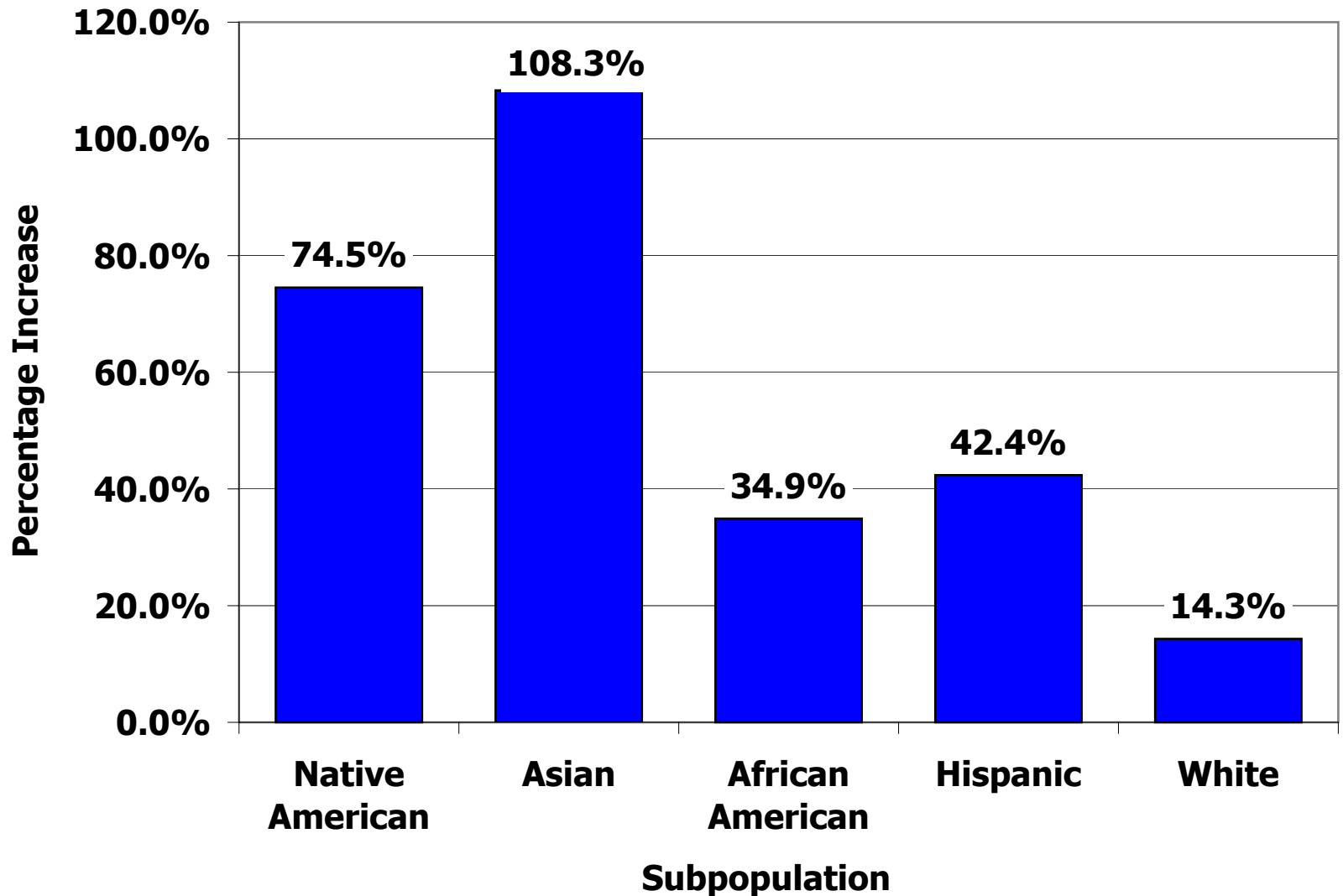
The total number of teacher for each year differs from totals in other docuemnts due to two reasons:
