



Special Education Enrollment



SPECIAL EDUCATION EVALUATIONS

Students who may qualify for special education services undergo an initial evaluation, and the number of these evaluations has increased significantly in recent years. As part of changes in House Bill 2, new formula funding provides schools with an additional \$1,000 for each initial special education evaluation conducted for any student who may have a disability, including those not enrolled in public schools.



STUDENTS SERVED THROUGH SPECIAL EDUCATION WITH THE SPECIFIC LEARNING DISABILITY (SLD) OF DYSLLEXIA²⁴

House Bill 3928 (88R) required dyslexia to be evaluated as a specific learning disability eligible for special education. As a result, school systems across Texas are serving far higher numbers of students with the specific learning disability of dyslexia. Schools receive additional special education formula funding when serving students with dyslexia as a specific learning disability, along with the dyslexia allotment.
