Applicants are responsible for submitting detailed information to ensure TEA is able to make accurate determinations.

Such as:

- Introductions to school environment and processes
- Enrollment information in extracurricular activities and clubs
- Tutoring opportunities
- Student code of conduct
- Contact information of pertinent school staff
- Information on the process for providing academic records to the receiving LEA

## Enrollment and Registration

- Information regarding the process and requirements for enrollment
- A checklist of required documentation needed to enroll at the campus
- Eligibility requirements for free public-school prekindergarten

## Academic Planning

- Course sequences, graduation requirements, and college and career readiness options
- Advanced Placement, Dual Credit, Dual Enrollment, or Career and Technical Education options available on campus
- Information on the Interstate Compact

## Counseling and Support Services

- Eligibility and referral counseling information offered specifically to military-connected families on a military installation.
- Eligibility and referral counseling information offered specifically to military-connected families within the local community.

## Campus-based Military Liaison information

- Contact information (email, phone, and photo)
- Military liaison job description and duties
