### "Best Practices in ECE: Guide" Background Information

- 1. Parts of the introduction section of the 2015 TXPKG were taken out to provide a condensed version of the 2022 TXPKGs, with a focus on skills and outcomes. The decision was made to compile that content as a separate resource.
- 2. PKG focus groups determined the need for more support with best practices in Kindergarten and guidance for ECE Administrators.
- 3. The content in these guides required:
  - A review of current research in the ECE field
  - A condensed and easily accessible format (webpages)
  - Exemplars






## <u>Classroom organization that supports</u> routines

- norms (e.g., looking eyes, listening ears)
- procedures (e.g., fire drill, arrival/dismissal)
- Labeled objects with print/picture for identification (e.g., cubbies, focus wall )
- Charts or Visual scaffolds
  - Visual daily schedule
  - Attendance
  - Helper charts
  - Planning charts (e.g., learning centers)
  - Concept chart (e.g., vocabulary list)
  - Letter/word wall

Other possible centers/stations in the ECE classroom:

- Creative arts (music, dance, theater)






### **TEM** Administrator Guide- Learning Centers in Prekindergarten

#### The role of the classroom staff during learning centers:

Communication	Safety and Supervision
<ul> <li>Actively play and engage with all children in centers/stations</li> <li>Facilitate social interactions among peers</li> <li>Comment on child's play schema</li> <li>Opportunities for formative assessment</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>be vigilant</li> <li>anticipate children's behavior</li> <li>be aware of problem-solving challenges that may occur between peer-to-peer interactions</li> <li>be actively engaged with children who require additional support</li> </ul>

### TEM Administrator Guide- Daily Schedules in Prekindergarten

**Effective** PK3 and PK4 daily classroom schedules should include:

**Integrated learning** 

A balance between teacher-directed and child-driven (choice) learning experiences

Developmentally appropriate, hands-on, play-based activities

**Intentionally designed** opportunities

Opportunities for relationship-building and communicative experiences with peers



# Administrator Guide- Daily Schedules in Prekindergarten

#### **Schedule and Activity Guidance:**

- Referenced throughout the school day, and consistently followed
- Time for transitions and self-help procedures
- Daily group activities should include crosscontent learning experiences throughout the school day.

#### **Calendar Time:**

- Activities that support child development and the concept of time
  - Time within a day (PK3/PK4.V.D.4) vs. length of time across days/weeks/months
