HQPK- Teacher Qualifications Legislation



STATUTE:

Per <u>TEC Sec. 29.167(b)</u> Each teacher for a prekindergarten program class must:

(1) be certified under Subchapter B, Chapter 21

RULE:

19 TAC §102.1003 (f) (4) In a format prescribed by the Texas Education Agency (TEA), a school district or an open-enrollment charter school shall:

(4) Report additional teacher qualifications described in subsection (d) of this section

19 TAC §102.1003 (d) Each teacher of record in a high-quality prekindergarten program must be certified under the TEC, Chapter 21, Subchapter B, and have one of the following additional qualifications



Additional Teacher Qualifications (Per District Classroom Teachers)



Options (Code Table ID)	Appropriately certified to teach early childhood	Additional qualification for teachers in a LEA-provided Prekindergarten Classroom:
Option #1 (Code 01)	Yes	Certification offered through a training center accredited by Association Montesorri Internationale or through the Montessori Accreditation Council for Teacher Education
Option #2 (Code 03)	Yes	Be employed as a prekindergarten teacher in a school district that has ensured specific prekindergarten professional development has been met: a. Has completed 150 hours of professional development in ECE-specific topics over a consecutive five-year period; 75 of the 150 hours being in a mentoring/coaching relationship or; a. Completes 30 hours of ECE-specific professional development annually with 15 of the 30 hours being in a mentoring/coaching relationship until 150 hours are documented
Option #3 (Code 05)	Yes	A Child Development Associate (CDA) credential
Option #4 (Code 06)	Yes	Documented completion of the Texas School Ready Training Program (TSR Comprehensive)
Option #5 (Code 07)	Yes	*A <mark>n associate or baccalaureate degree</mark> in early childhood education or a related field
Option #6 (Code 08)	Yes	*At least eight years' experience of teaching in a nationally accredited child care program or Texas Rising Star Program

Updated by House Bill 2729 in the 88th Texas Legislature Effective Sept. 1, 2023



Teacher Qualifications for PK Teachers in a Contracted PK Classroom



HB 2729 includes guidance around contract entities: (b-1) each teacher for a prekindergarten class provided by an entity with which a school district contracts to provide a prekindergarten program must:

(1) be supervised by a person who meets the requirements under Subsection (b); and

2) have one of the following qualifications:



Teacher Qualifications for PK Teachers in a Contracted PK Classroom



Options (Code Table (D)	Appropriately certified to teach early childhood	Qualification for teachers in a Prekindergarten Classroom provided by an entity with which a school district contracts to provide a Prekindergarten program (29.167 (b-1)):
Option #1 (Code 09)	No	Contract Entity - At least two years' experience of teaching in a nationally accredited child care program or Texas Rising Star Program and a Child Development Associate (CDA) credential or another early childhood education credential approved by the agency
Option #2 (Code 10)	No	Contract Entity - At least two years' experience of teaching in a nationally accredited child care program or Texas Rising Star Program and a certification offered through a training center accredited by Association Montessori Internationale or through the Montessori Accreditation Council for Teacher Education
Option #3 (Code 11)	No	Contract Entity - Been employed as a prekindergarten teacher in a school district that has ensured specific prekindergarten professional development requirements have been met a. Has completed 150 hours of professional development in ECE-specific topics over a consecutive five-year period; 75 of the 150 hours being in a mentoring/coaching relationship or;
		b. Completes 30 hours of ECE-specific professional development annually with 15 of the 30 hours being in a mentoring/coaching relationship until 150 hours are documented
Option #4 (Code 12)	No	Contract Entity - An associate or baccalaureate degree in early childhood or a related field
Option #5 (Code 13)	No	Contract Entity - At least eight years' experience of teaching in a nationally accredited child care program or Texas Rising Star Program



High-Quality Prekindergarten Qualifications



19 TAC §102.1003 (i) A school district or an open-enrollment charter school shall maintain locally and provide at the TEA's request the necessary documentation to ensure fidelity of high-quality prekindergarten program implementation

Early Childhood Data System (ECDS) Coding



Requirements

Each LEA prekindergarten teacher has a current Texas certification that enables them to teach prekindergarten OR a contracted prekindergarten teacher that is supervised by a prekindergarten teacher that meets all HQPK requirements

Each prekindergarten teacher meets one of the qualifications (as applicable per LEA teacher or contracted entity)

Each prekindergarten teacher's unique ID and qualifications are identified in ECDS annually

The LEA maintains the appropriate records to document compliance with this high-quality component


