

## HIGH-QUALITY PREKINDERGARTEN COMPONENT (PK4 Only) – TEACHER QUALIFICATIONS

Personnel teaching eligible four-year-old students in Texas must be appropriately certified to teach prekindergarten and have an "additional qualification."

HIGH-QUALITY PREKINDERGARTEN COMPONENT (PK4 Only) – TEACHER QUALIFICATIONS (CONTRACT ENTITY)

Each teacher for a prekindergarten class provided by an entity with which a school district contracts to provide a prekindergarten program must:

- (1) be supervised by a person who meets the requirements under Subsection (b); and
- (2) have one of the following qualifications
