Although abstinence is the only 100-percent effective method for preventing STIs, a correctly used condom can also reduce the chances of contracting some STIs. A condom is a birth control device that acts as a barrier against pathogens during sexual activity. Other birth control methods, such as withdrawal, birth control pills, sterilization, and intrauterine devices (IUDs), do not reduce the risk of STIs.

Condoms may be external or internal. An external condom fits over an erect penis. An internal condom fits inside the vagina.

A condom's material can influence effectiveness. Latex and some nonlatex condoms, such as those made of polyurethane or polyisoprene, help prevent the transmission of STIs. Condoms made of natural materials (for example, lambskin condoms) do not help prevent STIs. This is because condoms made of natural materials contain tiny holes through which pathogens can pass.

Condoms are risky in that they may fail. They are not as effective as abstinence at preventing STIs (Figure 19.8). To reduce the risk of STI transmission, a condom must be used correctly every time. Even if a condom is used correctly, STIs can still spread through contact with sores and areas not covered.

Barrier Methods

A correctly used barrier method called a condom can also reduce the chances of contracting some STIs; although abstinence is the only 100-percent effective method for preventing STIs. Other birth control and barrier methods do not reduce the risk of STIs.

There is always the risk a condom will fail. Condoms are not as effective as abstinence at preventing STIs (Figure 19.8). Even if a condom is used correctly, STIs can still spread through contact with sores and areas not covered.

Although abstinence is the only 100-percent effective method for preventing STIs, a correctly used condom can also reduce the chances of contracting some STIs. A condom is a birth control device that acts as a barrier against pathogens during sexual activity. Other birth control methods, such as withdrawal, birth control pills, sterilization, and intrauterine devices (IUDs), do not reduce the risk of STIs.

Condoms may be external or internal. An external condom fits over an erect penis. An internal condom fits inside the vagina.

A condom's material can influence effectiveness. Latex and some nonlatex condoms, such as those made of polyurethane or polyisoprene, help prevent the transmission of STIs. Condoms made of natural materials (for example, lambskin condoms) do not help prevent STIs. This is because condoms made of natural materials contain tiny holes through which pathogens can pass.

Condoms are risky in that they may fail. They are not as effective as abstinence at preventing STIs (Figure 19.8). To reduce the risk of STI transmission, a condom must be used correctly every time. Even if a condom is used correctly, STIs can still spread through contact with sores and areas not covered.

Barrier Methods

A correctly used barrier method called a condom can also reduce the chances of contracting some STIs; although abstinence is the only 100-percent effective method for preventing STIs. Other birth control and barrier methods do not reduce the risk of STIs.

There is always the risk a condom will fail. Condoms are not as effective as abstinence at preventing STIs (Figure 19.8). Even if a condom is used correctly, STIs can still spread through contact with sores and areas not covered.
