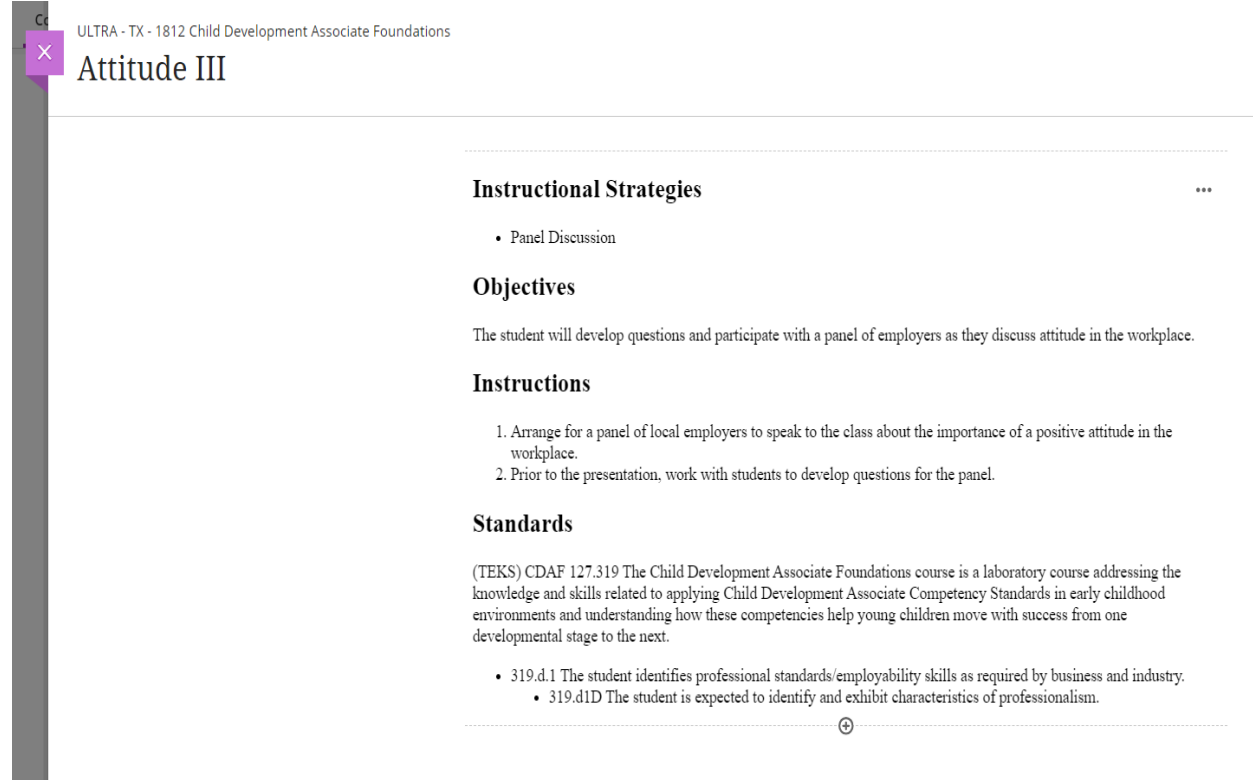

4. Assign each pair to develop a scenario in which an individual is faced with an ethical dilemma at work.
5. Have students switch scenarios with each other and determine what action the individual should take.
6. Instruct students to consider each of the questions from the slide as they determine what the individual should do.
7. Have each pair create a comic strip to illustrate the scenarios and actions of the individuals.

7. Have each pair reflect and develop a list of ethical work practices to share with the class. Post the lists on class webpage or student work board in the classroom.
