Parent-Teacher Planning Tool

It is important to make connections from one grade to the next for your child. Before the school year ends, ask your child's teacher which skills to focus on over the summer and what to share with summer tutors and program leaders.

1 ASK ABOUT GRADE-LEVEL PROGRESS

Example questions for the teacher:

Is my child on grade level in math and reading?



2 REFLECT ON SUMMER OPPORTUNITIES

Example questions for the teacher:

What do you think we need to work on with my child this summer to be ready for the next grade?

3 TEAM UP ON A PLAN

Example questions for the teacher and campus leader:

What programs are available at this campus, and what resources (online and offline) do you recommend for my child?

Where has my child done well and where does my child need more support?

In what subject (s) do you think my child needs acceleration or enrichment during the summer? What is most important for me to share with summer tutors or program leaders about my child's progress?
