FLVS Timeline





Founded in 1996 in a partnership between Orange County and Alachua County public schools.



In 1997, the school was officially named Florida High School and received a grant from the Florida Department of Education to pilot a "Web School" with five (5) online high school courses.



In 2001, the school was renamed Florida Virtual School.



Today, FLVS K-12 digital curriculum is used in all **67 Florida school districts** at the local County Virtual Schools, either directly through a district or a consortium.

School districts operate their own County Virtual Schools




FLVS licenses digital curriculum and online platforms (LMS/SIS*) to school districts (or individual schools)



Teachers are employed by the local school district



District teachers are trained by FLVS





FLVS Funding Model





Funded as part of the **FEFP** (Florida Education Finance Program)



Performance-based funding (funded by student course completion, not per enrollment)



FLVS only receives funding when students **successfully complete courses** in Flex and Full Time schools




FLVS funding is equal to 7/10's of FTE paid to traditional brick and mortar districts (cost savings to the state)


