- Enrollment information in extracurricular activities and clubs
- Tutoring opportunities
- Student code of conduct
- Contact information of pertinent school staff
- Information on the process for providing academic records to the receiving LEA

Enrollment and Registration (all required)

- Information regarding the process and requirements for enrollment
- A checklist of required documentation needed to enroll at the campus
- Eligibility requirements for free public-school prekindergarten

Academic Planning (all required)

- Course sequences, graduation requirements, and college and career readiness options
- Advanced Placement, Dual Credit, Dual Enrollment, or Career and Technical Education options available on campus
- Information on the Interstate Compact

Counseling and Support Services (all required)

- Eligibility and referral counseling information offered specifically to military-connected families on a military installation.
- Eligibility and referral counseling information offered specifically to military-connected families within the local community.

Campus-based Military Liaison information (all required)

- Contact information (Name, email, and phone; photo is optional)
- Campus-based Military liaison's job description and/or duties
