Noncompliance Dear Mrs. Yolanda Chapa:

The purpose of this correspondence is to notify the Santa Rosa Independent School District (ISD) of the correction of noncompliance identified in the Desk Review for special education.

Santa Rosa ISD received notification of noncompliance in a letter dated 7/29/2022 listing the following area of noncompliance:

- Present Level of Academic Achievement and Functional Performance (PLAAFP)  
**34 Code of Federal Regulations §300.320(a)(1)**
- Benchmarks or short-term objectives  
**34 CFR § 300.320 (a)(2)(ii)**
- LPAC representative  
**Texas Administrative Code: §TAC 89.1050(c)(1)(j)**

A plan for correction of the noncompliance was included in your corrective action plan. Subsequently, Santa Rosa ISD was required to submit documentation to the Texas Education Agency (TEA) verifying correction for the issue of noncompliance noted above. The documentation submitted by the LEA indicated that this area of noncompliance has been addressed and the noncompliance has been corrected. Therefore, no further action on this issue is required at this time.
