Subject: Notification of Correction of Noncompliance

Dear Dr. Mark Henry:

The purpose of this correspondence is to notify the Cypress-Fairbanks Independent School District (ISD) of the correction of noncompliance identified in the Cyclical Desk Review.

Cypress-Fairbanks ISD received notification of noncompliance in a letter dated 4/29/2022 listing the following area of noncompliance:

- IEP Development
 - ID4/ID5 – 34 CFR §300.320(a)(3)

A plan for correction of the noncompliance was included in your corrective action plan. Subsequently, the local education agency (LEA) was required to submit documentation to the Texas Education Agency (TEA) verifying correction for the issue of noncompliance noted above. The documentation submitted by the LEA indicated that this area of noncompliance has been addressed and the noncompliance has been corrected. Therefore, no further action on this issue is required at this time.
