Subject: Notification of Correction of Noncompliance

Dear Dr. Dwaine Augustine:

The purpose of this correspondence is to notify the Hamshire-Fannett Independent School District (ISD) of the correction of noncompliance identified in the Cyclical Desk Review.

Hamshire-Fannett ISD received notification of noncompliance in a letter dated 7/29/2022 listing the following areas of noncompliance:

- Present Levels of Academic Achievement and Functional Performance
34 Code of Federal Regulations § 300.320(a)(1)
- IEP Measurable Goals
34 CFR § 300.320(a)(2)(i)
- Intensive Program of Instruction
Texas Education Code § 28.0213

A plan for correction of the noncompliance was included in your corrective action plan. Subsequently, the local education agency (LEA) was required to submit documentation to the Texas Education Agency (TEA) verifying correction for the issues of noncompliance noted above. The documentation submitted by the LEA indicated that these areas of noncompliance have been addressed and the noncompliance has been corrected. Therefore, no further action on these issues is required at this time.
