The purpose of this correspondence is to notify the Queen City Independent School District (ISD) of the correction of noncompliance identified in the Cyclical Desk Review.

Subsequently, the local education agency (LEA) was required to submit documentation to the Texas Education Agency (TEA) verifying correction for the issue of noncompliance noted above.
