Subject: Notification of Correction of Noncompliance

Dear Dr. Belding:

The purpose of this correspondence is to notify the Midlothian Independent School District (ISD) of the correction of noncompliance identified in the Desk Review for special education.

Midlothian ISD received notification of noncompliance in a letter dated 1/31/2023 listing the following areas of noncompliance:

- **IEP Development:** 34 CFR §300.320(a)(3)(ii)
- Transition: TEC §29.017(c); 19 TAC §89.1049(a)

A plan for correction of the noncompliance was included in your corrective action plan. Subsequently, the local education agency (LEA) was required to submit documentation to the Texas Education Agency (TEA) verifying correction for the issues of noncompliance noted above. The documentation submitted by the LEA indicated that these areas of noncompliance have been addressed and the noncompliance has been corrected. Therefore, no further action on these issues is required at this time.
