The purpose of this correspondence is to notify the Scurry-Rosser Independent School District (ISD) of the correction of noncompliance identified in the Cyclical Desk Review.

Scurry-Rosser ISD received notification of noncompliance in a letter dated 4/30/2023 listing the following area of noncompliance:

- Frequency, Location, and Duration of Services
