Dear Dr. Heskett:

The purpose of this correspondence is to notify the Covington Independent School District (ISD) of the correction of noncompliance identified in the Cyclical Desk Review.

Covington ISD received notification of noncompliance in a letter dated 7/29/2022 listing the following areas of noncompliance:

- IEP Development:
  - 34 CFR §300.320(a)(3): Description of methods used to measure/evaluate student success/progress.

A plan for correction of the noncompliance was included in your corrective action plan. Subsequently, the local education agency (LEA) was required to submit documentation to the Texas Education Agency (TEA) verifying correction for the issue of noncompliance noted above. The documentation submitted by the LEA indicated that this area of noncompliance has been addressed and the noncompliance has been corrected. Therefore, no further action on this issue is required at this time.
