Subject: Notification of Correction of Noncompliance

Dear Mr. Ronald Beard:

The purpose of this correspondence is to notify the Mullin Independent School District (ISD) of the correction of noncompliance identified in the Cyclical Desk Review.

Mullin ISD received notification of noncompliance in a letter dated 7/29/2022 listing the following areas of noncompliance:

- IEP Development: Development of Measurable Annual Goals
34 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) §300.320(a)(2)(i)
- IEP Development: Description of methods used to measure/evaluate student success/progress
34 CFR §300.320(a)(3)

A plan for correction of the noncompliance was included in your corrective action plan. Subsequently, the local education agency (LEA) was required to submit documentation to the Texas Education Agency (TEA) verifying correction for the issue of noncompliance noted above. The documentation submitted by the LEA indicated that this area of noncompliance
